

## **The Ohio State University Alumni Association Alumni Club of Greater Kansas City**

The Ohio State University Alumni Scholars Program (ASP) is intended to provide recognition and financial assistance to outstanding incoming freshman. The Ohio State University Alumni Association coordinates the program, with the support of the local alumni club, the offices of Admissions and Financial Aid, and the Office of University Development.

Your local alumni club will offer at least one Alumni Scholarship award. It is a \$2,500 minimum, merit-based scholarship. The standards of selection for this award are:

- Ranking in the top 25% of your high school graduating class
- Demonstrating involvement in school and community activities
- Showing a sound interest and positive attitude toward college work

You should complete Part I of the application and then have your principal, counselor or teacher complete Part II, which will recommend you for the scholarship. It is very important that this person attach a copy of your transcript to the application. The alumni club scholarship chairperson must receive the completed application, with transcript, no later than February 1. The chairperson's name and address can be found on the second page of the application.

You must also complete an Undergraduate Admission Application in order to be considered for this scholarship; the application can be found in The Ohio State University Viewbook and Freshman Application booklet. Viewbooks are available from your high school guidance counselor or you may apply online at [www.osu.edu](http://www.osu.edu).

Award letters from the Office of Student Financial Aid are mailed to student scholarship recipients beginning in April. The letter lists the aid a student is eligible to receive. If you are a recipient of an alumni scholarship award, it will be listed as the Alumni Scholars Program. There are occasions when the recipient is not determined until summer.

### **National Buckeye for Non-ohio residents**

Ohio State is committed to enrolling a diverse and talented student population. Two merit awards are available to qualified students who are admitted to the Columbus campus for fall quarter and are required to pay the out-of-state surcharge. These awards are renewable for a maximum of 12 quarters of full-time enrollment provided the recipient maintains a 2.5 or higher GPA from the second year forward and makes satisfactory academic progress. *Note:* National Buckeye awards can be combined with any other merit scholarships, not to exceed the total value of an Ohio State education. #### *National Buckeye Award*

This award is open to non-Ohio residents with an ACT composite score of 24–25 or combined SAT Critical Reading and Math score of 1090–1170.  
Award amount: \$3,950 (\$15,800 four-year value)

#### *National Buckeye Plus Scholarship*

This award is open to non-Ohio residents with an ACT composite score of 26+ or combined SAT Critical Reading and Math score of 1180+.  
Award amount: \$6,600 (\$26,400 four-year value)
