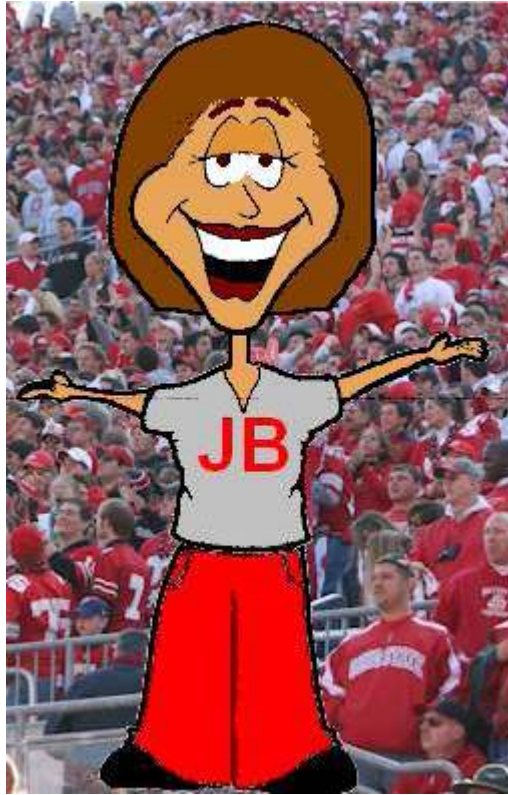


## JENNY BUCKS

### Greetings C-Bus:

The Bucks signed 19 football prospects today, National Letter of Intent Day. The class is led by 3 blue chip offensive linemen who Tressel credited with bringing in more recruits. It is likely one of the OL stars, rated all in the top 10 in the nation, will make a mark on the field next season. Nine of the 19 are Ohioans and the class is split 8 offense, 10 defense and 1 specialist. An unsung star in the class will probably prove to be DeVier Posey, a true speedster wide receiver (largely considered a shoo-in sub 4.4 speed) at 6'3". The Glenville connection also brought 2 of the 9 Ohioans to the group. The details of the class follow.

But the most talked about has been the one unsigned prospect, Terrelle Pryor. Today his press conference revealed more of the same from this young man. Namely, I don't know. I'm taking more visits. Pryor has added Penn State and Oregon to the list of supposed favorites Ohio State and Michigan. Today was the first day to sign. April 1 is the last. Somewhere in

between, the nation's #1 recruit will likely sign with someone.
